Requirements:

- ❖ You must be a 2010 graduate of a Pulaski County School
- ❖ You must complete the application and compose a typed, 12 font, double spaced, 250-300 word essay describing the most important issue affecting the health, safety, and welfare of today's families and youth of Pulaski County. In the essay include the following:
 1. Description of issue.
 2. Identify the cause and effect of the issue.
 3. Personal reflection of how this affects you and your family.
 4. Who is responsible for a solution to this issue?
 5. How would you solve this issue?
- ❖ Deadline for application and essay submission is June 4, 2010. Submit application to Waynesville High School Guidance office or contact Jana Keeling.
- ❖ Five finalist will be chosen by a review board comprised of Pulaski County citizens.
- ❖ Finalist will be expected to work with the Fair Board and community volunteers to prepare the fair grounds June 16, 2010 from 2:00-6:00, where fair board members will get to know each finalist.
- ❖ Upon completion of fair ground preparation three finalist will be chosen to return to the St. Robert Community Center 6:00 June 17, 2010 to go before the Fair Board to defend their essay. A Queen and Runner-Up Princess will be chosen.
- ❖ The Fair Queen and Princess are required to be actively present during fair open hours to greet patrons and perform various duties at fair events.

The Queen is expected to represent Pulaski County at various events during her year-long tenure and be active in planning and preparing for the 2011-2012 Pulaski County Fair Activities.
